From Madrid to Cáceres

Bus trip in the direction of Cáceres

Delightful tapas lunch in the picturesque Plaza Mayor.

Guided tour of the medieval city of Cáceres. Cáceres is one of the **UNESCO World Heritage Cities in Spain.** The city, with the third largest monumental ensemble in Europe, with streets, squares, palaces and walls that are **particularly well preserved**, will transport you back to the Renaissance and the Middle Ages.

Guided tour of **Museo de Arte Contemporáneo Helga de Alvear.** This renowned contemporary art museum in Cáceres showcases an extraordinary collection of over 3,000 works by leading international artists, including Louise Bourgeois, Jenny Holzer, Richard Long, and Thomas Hirschhorn. Designed by the award-winning architect Emilio Tuñón, the museum is a striking example of modern architecture and a beacon for contemporary art, offering a fascinating contrast to the historic surroundings of Cáceres.

Museo Vostell Malpartida

Guided tour of the Museo Vostell Malpartida.

The Museo Vostell Malpartida, located near Cáceres in Malpartida de Cáceres, is a unique museum dedicated to Fluxus art, founded by German painter, sculptor, Fluxus- and Happening artist Wolf Vostell in 1976. Set within a natural park and a historic wool-washing site, it combines avant-garde art with a striking landscape, showcasing works that challenge traditional artistic boundaries.

Discover MK Kaehne's thought-provoking **exhibition** *"Bar De Luxe – The Reversal of the Readymade of conceptual art*, inspired by the museum's renowned Fluxus collection (Donation Gino di Maggio). This exhibition features a captivating selection of sculptures, objects, and photographs that challenge traditional notions of art.

Drawing influences from Russian Constructivism and Moscow Conceptualism, Kaehne explores the tension between art and functionality. By reimagining everyday objects with luxurious designs and full functionality, the artist transforms them into industrial-like art pieces that defy practical use, sparking questions about the role of art in contemporary society.

As part of this unique experience, you will have the opportunity to **meet the artist MK Kaehne** and gain deeper insights into the ideas and processes behind the work.

Day 4 - Sun, 09/03

Explore Los Barruecos Natural Monument, a stunning natural landscape, home to two iconic sculptures integrated into the granite rock formations: V.O.A.E.X. (Concrete Journey through Upper Extremadura), a concrete-encased Opel Admiral created by Vostell in 1976, and El Muerto que tiene Sed (The Dead Who Is Thirsty) (1978).

Networking-Lunch together with the Circle of Friends of the Museo Vostell Malpartida: a perfect occasion for connection and conversation.

Tour of **Palacio de Topete**, former studio and residence of the German artist Wolf Vostell, an 18th-century manor house restored by Wolf and Mercedes Vostell in 1977. This space hosted the Week of Contemporary Art in 1978, one of Extremadura's first contemporary art exhibitions. The village of Malpartida became their second home, symbolizing their lifelong connection to the area.

Anemone Vostell, Sculpture Network Coordinator and curator of *BAR DELUXE*, has a deep personal connection with the Museo Vostell Malpartida and over 25 years of experience in the international art world. As a gallery partner, independent curator, and cultural manager, she has spearheaded numerous projects in Germany and abroad, including leading the Berlin Galleries Association and launching initiatives like Art From Berlin presentations, art tours, and artist residencies. In 2020, she founded BAM! Berlin Art Management, specialised in art projects and consulting.

Her close relationship with artist MK Kaehne and her deep ties to the Fluxus movement inspired her to bring Kaehne's work to the Museo Vostell Malpartida. Kaehne's Lithuanian heritage and artistic journey between Moscow and Berlin offer a compelling dialogue with the museum's Fluxus pieces, especially those from the Donación di Maggio Collection.
